

Code of conduct.

Youth Soccer Trips in This Country & Abroad.

- 1. All members of the party must conduct themselves in a responsible manner at all times to uphold the good name of Stony Stratford Town Football Club.**
- 2. The Main Club Committee must be informed of all trips before they are booked and given accurate information on dates, venues etc.**
- 3. Managers must ensure the appropriate insurance is obtained; to give all parties involved adequate cover.**
- 4. Managers must hold a parents meeting before leaving on any trip, to ensure all parties are informed of all the arrangements involved and iron out any possible problems that may have arisen.**
- 5. A maximum of six youth players per adult taking part in any trip organised, all persons taking part in any trip are answerable to the trip organiser.**
- 6. All junior members of the party must refrain from drinking alcohol at all times; smoking and bad language will not be tolerated under any circumstances.**
- 7. Any juniors that misbehave will be reported to the main committee and an appropriate punishment will be agreed upon.**
- 8. Any medical treatment that a child is receiving should be reported to the person in overall control, to ensure the junior receives the appropriate treatment while away on the trip.**
- 9. These guidelines are for the benefit of everybody involved with youth teams at Stony Stratford Town Football Club.**
